

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



AUDITORIUM - LEVEL 1

The Platform is an experimental forum proposing over the course of four days, a series of conversations following various axes. Each day opens with a focus on the theme of the collection with invited collectors.

DAVID CAMPANY - A QUESTION OF COLOURWHAT COLOUR IS AESTHETICALLY, SOCIALLY, TECHNICALLY FOR PHOTOGRAPHY

For the previous generation, colour in art photography shifted from being a novelty to becoming the default, standard option. However, colour has changed a great deal in recent years, partly through the capabilities of digital cameras and partly through the leaps made in printing and colour publishing. Walker Evans once described colour photography as vulgar and therefore valid "when the point of a picture is precisely its vulgarity or its colour-accident through man's hands, not God's." Evans was writing in 1969, when colour reproduction was still quite crude. He would change his mind if he saw how sensitive it has become. Organised by David Campany, a writer, curator and artist, the aim of this Platform series is to bring together younger practitioners who are at the forefront of using colour in innovative ways, older photographers whose work in colour continues to be influential, and now, thanks to digital prints, look better than ever.

MOUNA MEKOUAR-THE PHOTOGRAPH DECEIVES AND SHOWS THAT IT DECEIVES Curator and art critic Mouna Mekouar will grasp the complexity of the photographic medium in order to compare the approaches of different artists who have felt the need to integrate it into their own work. There will be, therefore, as many responses as questions asked by the artists. Multiple and plural, their works are direct emanations of reality and/or interior projections of the psyche. Based on different models of perception, they condition our ability to see and participate in the construction of our gaze. Depending on the situation, the artists endow these images with a degree of darkness; explore their changing status and ubiquity; further their connections to art and its borders with reality; but also, investigate the process by which an image eliminates itself, in a backwards game that plays with the phenomenon of dematerialisation.

CRISTIANO RAIMONDI - FROM THE DOCUMENTATION OF REALITY OF THE PIONEERS TO THE META-REALITY OF THE DIGITAL UNIVERSE

A consequence of the desire for knowledge in the age of Enlightenment, the discovery and dissemination of photography in the first half of the 19th century are among other things part of a more specific context: the democratisation of knowledge. At the end of the 20th century, the various technological and social. revolutions brought about the era of digital photography. Today, with the normalisation of the Internet, photography is "shared" en masse on various digital platforms, thus engaging new forms of images and other forms of information. Cristiano Raimondi, Head of Development and International Projects at the Nouveau Musée National de Monaco, will discuss how historians, artists, and scientists fit into this evolution, as well as future prospects.

The winner for the First PhotoBook category will receive a \$10,000 prize. The winners of the other two categories will each receive a commemorative award.

The winners will be announced on Friday, November 10th at 1pm at Paris Photo. Thirty-five titles shortlisted from nearly 1000 submissions will be on display during the fair and profiled in the 013 issue of PhotoBook Review, a bi-annual publication created by Aperture Foundation and distributed during the Fair. The exhibition will be subsequently presented at Aperture Gallery in New York and will travel internationally thereafter.
